A-7601	Justice	Withdrawn/ Discontinued		On Dec.14, 2018 the Supreme Court of Canada released the court case R v Boudrealt (2018 SCC 58) striking down the mandatory victim fine surcharge (VFS) under s. 737 of the Criminal Code. I am leading a Yukon Legal Services Society project researching potential appeals for every client represented by our clinic who had a VFS imposed on them since mandatory VFS was enacted. To narrow down the number of appellants to a manageable level, we are researching bringing the appeals only for those clients who have actually paid the VFS. We are not notified when our clients pay the VFS, and as such we have no record of that. The public body has unique control and access to this information. As a result of this request I am hoping to get: 1) a list of names of people who have paid a s. 737 Criminal Code VFS in relation to a Criminal Code or Controlled Drugs and Substances Act offence committed on or after June 19 2013 (the date when the mandatory surcharge came into force); and 2) the court file numbers (the Information numbers) corresponding to the above. The results of this search will greatly assist us in our research into determining whether and how to most efficiently bring these appeals. I am prepared to offer undertakings as a barrister to ensure the information is used only for its proper purpose and kept under strict control.
